I have read through the consultation document on health care reform and I must say I object the six options listed in the document for the following reasons:

- 1) Given the experience of the MPF which mostly benefit the financial institutions, fund managers, stock market and not the employees, I can foresee that in the case of the health care reform, likewise only the insurance companies will be benefitted the most, not the citizens.
- 2) The reliability of the projections given by the government about the future financial burden created by the public health issue is questionable. I believe the projections are too pessimistic and the government should have adequate resources in meeting public health needs in future.
