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Subject Health care reform

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In connection with the healthcare reform, I strongly oppose any kind of compulsory contribution from the general public.

I consider this is ineffective due to the heavy cost of administration and heavy burden to the public especially to the low income class.

I propose that the healthcare reform should be made up from the following direction;

1. Voluntary medical insurance from the public with the same amount of contribution from the government.
2. Government uses the profit from the government reserve, one off set up cost of \$50,000 million for medical reform in the fiscal year 2009 and from foreign reserve fund operation expenses for the medical expenses.
3. The voluntary medical insurance should be tax deductible.
4. The government should expand the medical services e.g. build more hospitals, set up more in patient and out patient services and recruit and train up more doctors, nurses and related professionals so that the quality of medical services becomes better.
5. Increase the medical charges and receipt by reducing the subsidy from 95% to 80%. This could reduce the pressure on public service to private service.

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
